Key reminders

Punctuality - Since we have returned back to school after the summer break we are noticing an increase in lateness to school. I would like to remind families of our expectations regarding punctuality in the morning:

- Students must arrive in school by 08.55 on each school day
- Our main Front gate opens at 8.30am and the other two gates Turing and Ashurt will
- open at 8.45am. We have found that the majority of our children arrive at school
- between 8.45 and 8.55am.
- The register for the morning session will be taken at 9am. Students arriving after
- 9am will be coded as "L" for Late.
- If your child is late for the AM register then you will receive a message to inform you and your child will receive an appropriate sanction for their lateness.

ALL students are able to get free porridge from the canteen between 8-8.30am. Students wishing to take up this offer can enter the school from the reception area.
