The Easter break should not be viewed as a "holiday" by year 11 students. It is the time to make the final preparations so that students are "exam ready" for the Summer series.

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
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This is essential to ensure that we have enough staff on site to make the intervention effective, as we are aiming for a **maximum ratio** of 1 teacher for 10 students.
