Dear Stantonbury families,

We are writing to let you know that Year 10 reports will be published shortly. If you've not yet set up your Parent account on our "Go4Schools" platform, you'll need to do this in order to receive your child's report. A reminder of how to do this is included in the attachment.

Your child's report will contain a "Current Working At" grade for each of their examined subjects, and an "Attitude to Learning" comment.

The current grade indicates the attainment achieved in the recent assessment, completed within each subject. Current grades can move up, and down according to how well the child has completed the assessment, which will focus on different aspects of the overall course content and skills. Over the course of the programme of study, children will be assessed regularly on each aspect of the course, so that they are fully prepared for the final exam or assessment.

We have defined the attitude to learning comments as follows:

Outstanding	Confidently engages in all lessons. Completes all work set to a high standard. Demonstrates a passion for the subject. Participates frequently with insightful ideas, to the benefit of the class.
Very Good	Engages in all lessons. Completes all work set. Demonstrates enthusiasm for learning and an enjoyment of the subject. Makes valuable contributions to lessons, supporting the learning of others.
Good	Engages in most lessons. Completes most of the work set. Is keen to learn and do well. Participates well when asked.
Needs to Improve	Engages in some learning. Completes some of the work set. Participation is infrequent.
Inadequate	Does not engage in learning.

Following feedback from parents, we have renamed the "external target" as an "End of Year 11 target". We have based our targets using benchmarking against national data, which is then personalised for each child according to the subjects they study. We must stress that these are not "predicted", nor "projected" grades, and that in order to achieve these targets, students will have to apply themselves fully to their learning throughout their course of study.

This target will be shown against each subject on your child's report, so that you can see where they are in relation to their target. For each subject, a brief tracking comment will also

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help you to understand whether your child is currently on track to achieve their target based on the assessment.

When the reports are ready, you will receive an email notification containing a link directly to your child's report.
